UNIFORM POLICY

Fleet Wood Lane School believes that it is important to have a uniform which presents a shared identity. It ensures equality and inclusion for all. Whilst the school has commissioned a range of sweatshirts, cardigans (in sweatshirt material) rucksacks and book bags, which carry the school's logo (available from Shotbowl). These are not mandatory; supermarket/chain store products which comply with the policy are entirely acceptable. The school expects all children to wear the designated uniform during term time. Please note that fashion clothing is not acceptable at any time.

Uniform

- A red pullover, school sweatshirt or cardigan
- A white or red polo shirt
- A charcoal grey school skirt / school trousers / school pinafore dress / school culottes / school shorts
- A checked summer school dress in the school colours of red and white
- Plain grey tights, or socks in white or grey
- Black shoes (trainers are not acceptable)
- Hair accessories such as slides, ribbons bobbles, etc, should be fairly simple and if possible in school colours. Other head coverings (such as head scarves) may be worn at the Head Teacher's discretion.
- To enable children to access play on the field/playground in all weathers, children are asked to bring a pair of play out shoes and wellingtons to be stored in school.

PE Kit:

- A pair of navy
- A navy T shirt (logoed shirts available from Shotbowl).
- Trainers

Outdoor Games – Summer :

- As above, but a change of socks will be needed as well as trainers

Outdoor Games – Winter:

- The same as 'summer', but you will need a navy blue tracksuit or sweatshirt and jogging bottoms.

Swimming Kit

- Girls should wear a one-piece swimsuit and boys require close fitting swim shorts or trunks.

All children are expected to wear the school's published PE kit for all PE lessons and during attendance to all sports based after-school clubs. Parents are reminded that PE lessons are part of the National Curriculum. Parents' help in ensuring that children have the correct kit on the correct day is much appreciated. If however, your child has a valid reason for not doing these lessons, they must bring a note requesting permission to be excused for that lesson.

The school would appreciate the parent's co-operation on the following points:

- Please ensure that all items of clothing are clearly marked with the child's name.
- Children should wear good, strong, practical black shoes to school, suitable for indoor wear.
- Novelty footwear, such as slippers and shoes with platform soles and heels, are not suitable and should not be worn to school.
- For safety and security reasons, items of jewellery (such as necklaces, bracelets and rings) should not be worn. Watches may be worn, but they are the responsibility of the child and must be removed during Physical activities. Any jewellery required for medical or religious reasons, requires agreement by the Head Teacher.
- Mobile phones must not be brought to school, unless through prior permission from the Head Teacher; in which case they are to be given to the Reception Staff to store for safe-keeping during the day.
- Earrings - Pupils must remove their earrings prior to attending school on the days on which they have PE if the child cannot remove and replace themselves. Staff have been informed that they are not allowed to remove/replace jewellery for fear of damage, loss or injury. Nor should a member of staff apply any tape or plasters to cover the ear stud for fear of causing an allergic reaction, etc.
- School book bags carrying the school's logo can be purchased from Shotbowl. Parents are asked to provide their children with a bag of a similar size. Anything bigger may cause problems with storage.
- Parents are asked kindly to avoid the supply of overtly branded PE kit and seek instead plain low-cost options that provide a common standard and equity between pupils.

Fleet Wood Lane - Our Uniform

Girls

Red sweatshirt jumper/cardigan

(school logoed or plain)

White or red polo shirt

Dark grey (charcoal) trousers, dress, skirt or school shorts

Red and white checked dress

Red fleece jacket (outside wear)

Boys

Red sweatshirt jumper/cardigan

(school logoed or plain)

White or red polo shirt

Dark grey (charcoal) or trousers or school shorts

Red fleece jacket (outside wear)



White/red polo shirt worn tucked into trousers/skirts

Red logoed (or plain) sweatshirt, jumper or cardigan

Dark grey (charcoal) trousers, or shorts; dark grey school dress or skirt; red and white checked summer dresses

White, black or grey plain coloured socks or tights and black school shoes (no trainers)



Outdoor shoes/wellington boots

As we use the outdoor field at playtimes – in all seasons – your child will need a spare pair of shoes/trainers in school to change into at playtime. Wellingtons are needed in wet/winter weather, as the field can be muddy.

PE Kit

Plain navy-blue or school logoed T-shirt and navy-blue shorts for indoor lessons.

Children will also need trainers, navy-blue tracksuit or warm navy-blue leggings worn with a plain navy sweatshirt for outdoor games.

Fleece jackets, logoed jumpers/cardigans, logoed PE T-shirts, PE shorts, drawstring PE bags and book bags bearing the school logo, are available from Shotbowl or www.schooltrends.co.uk. Logoed uniform is not mandatory; plain - supermarket uniform is entirely acceptable.

It is essential that you name label all items of clothing and PE equipment, otherwise it is impossible for us to return misplaced items to their rightful owner. Sewn in name labels are the best - as they don't wash off or out!
