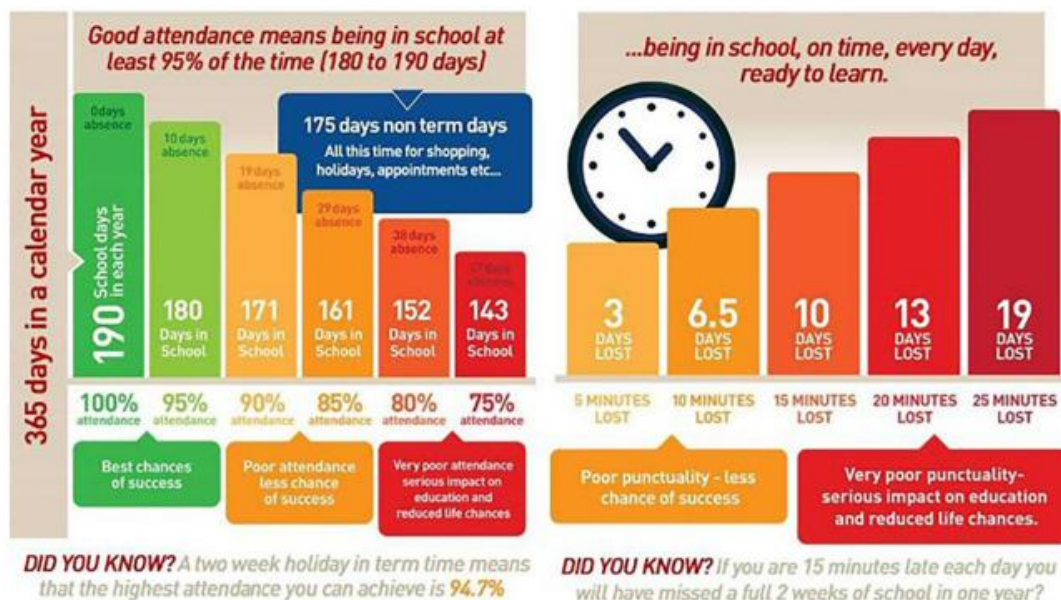

We do not want to fine families. The funds do not come to school. We are also tied to the new rules and we want your children to have good attendance and do well at school.


