Parking News

We have been able to meet with the Highways Agency to discuss the lack of available parking for parents outside of school. We are very pleased to share with you that there will be some changes to the parking bay beside the school field over the summer (on the left as you look at school) and that the current parking 'lay-by' is going to be widened to allow for better parking and easier passage of traffic on the lane beside parked cars. We will also be having a disabled parking bay painted beside Bats Classroom, closer to the front entrance of school. We are aware that parking is tricky and we are trying to support safe parking for everyone.



Please remember not to park in the 'no parking' area opposite the taxis, as this blocks their exit and entrance, as well as obstructing the traffic on the lane.

Lost Property

The lost property mountain is growing! Please encourage your child to go and look for their lost un-named items or ask to come and have a look through yourself! All items with names are returned to their owners promptly, so please check your name tags haven't come out in the wash!


