Dear Families,

We are pleased to be able to share that work to construct the new classroom will begin on Monday 5th January 2026. This project has been the work of several years by the Governing Body at Fleet Wood Lane Primary School, to replace a temporary mobile classroom with a more suitable, permanent structure.

Unfortunately, we are going to need to be both flexible and patient during the next few months, whilst work takes place and there will be some disruption to our daily routines. We will keep you updated as the project progresses and as we are made aware of any changes. Our main priority throughout will be the safety of our children, staff and extended families. It is helpful if you do communicate with us anything you observe that may become an issue, so please do come forward and talk to us.



The current plan is that the construction team, Lindum, will come in on our training day Monday 5th January and fence off the area they are going to be using during the build. This is the area around the current front entrance and part of the field to the left. There will be no access for children to the build site, it is completely fenced off and no access for construction workers to the school grounds. They also have a 'no radio' policy and no unsuitable language policy in place for the build.

We will begin to use the small white door as a temporary front entrance from Tuesday 6th January. There will be a camera set up so that we can see visitors at the door and the portable doorbell for squirrels will be used. **Please be patient**, it will be a long way from the office for staff to answer the door, there will be a desk set up closer for busy periods. **Please call before making any visit to school, other than morning drop off.**

Entry to school will be along the new pathway as before and through the pedestrian gate to the right of the building, as before. During the busy periods of drop off and collection, the constructors have a 'no move' policy for their vehicles and there will be no deliveries scheduled during this period. Taxi children will also enter through the pedestrian gate and staff on the gate will check them off on the clipboard. Taxis will be allowed to park directly in front of school to drop off.

Finally, children will continue to have access to our wonderful school field, except the area where the trim trail is currently, as this will be fenced off as part of the construction site.



The first part of the work will be a team of archaeologists, who will be checking that we are not a site of historical interest and then the building work can begin.

If you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to get in touch, we will keep you updated as the work progresses.
