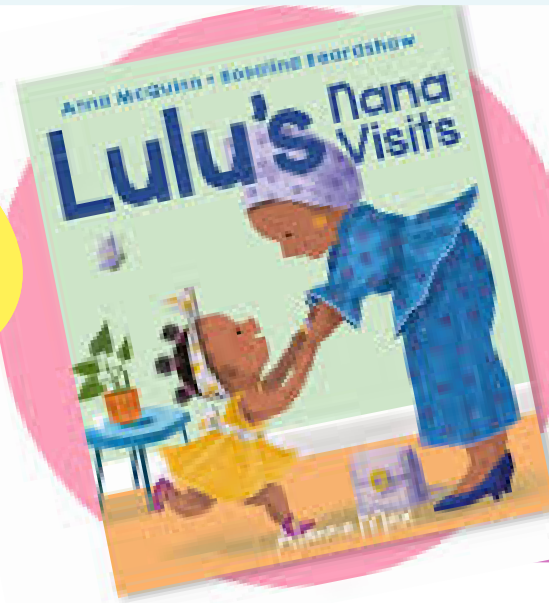


A Blossoming Spring 2 in Dormice
