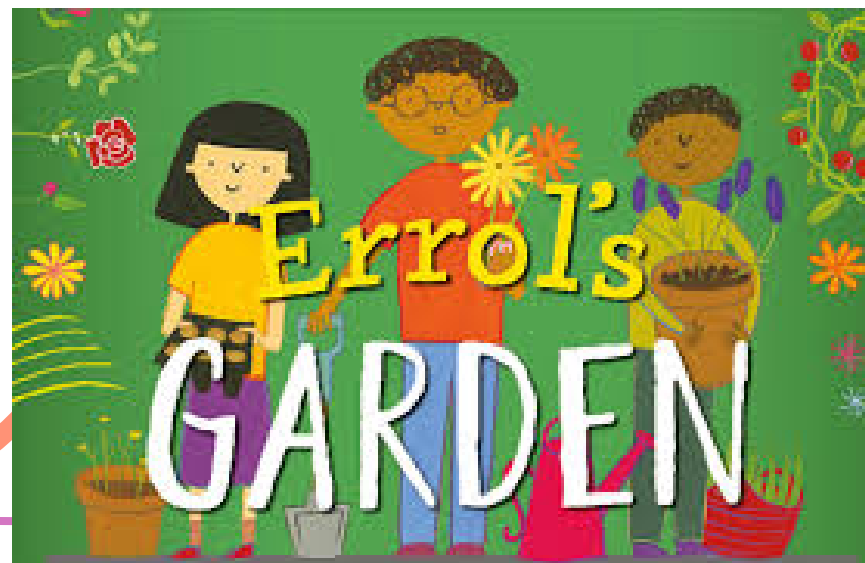


# Super start to the Summer term in Dormice
